## **Weekly Lesson Plan**

### **Literature:**

Book Title: Tubby

Author: Leslie Patricelli

### **Music and Rhythm:**

Song, fingerplay, or poem: Twinkle, Twinkle Little Star

### **Language Building Activity:**

As I hold Baby Z on my lap, I will encourage him to focus on me as I talk to him. As I speak, I will let him feel my mouth moving, the vibrations of my throat, the puffs of air, and the ways my mouth changes shape as I form different words.
