Children's time is so precious during the developing and formative years, which is a main reason to keep children learning everyday of their young lives. This is why we at Adventure Summer Camp combine education with summer fun. In many ways I wish that we offered year round schooling, as eleven weeks of summer, if not used wisely could cause the children to lose the great ability of keeping up with learning and forgetting what they have learned during the academic year.

Offering a variety of academic programs supports our philosophy of giving the children the gift of learning through the summer. Giving the students the chance to advance or catch up is one of our goals. Studying different countries during the summer goes very well with us having an International Baccalaureate Candidate school with an international student body.

When we talk about a global education to prepare our students for a bright future, we really mean it and we put it into practice. Every year I try to take two weeks to travel to a different corner of the world to stay connected with the world and to learn more about their education system. Last year I visited the Baltic Region. I was so impressed by the Norwegian, Swedish and Danish academic standards. What is different and common for these three countries is parent's choice. Meaning the government pays the tuition regardless where the student decides to go. Private Schools, Public Schools and Religious Schools are all treated equally and get paid the same amount of funds per student. Until we see that change in our society, we will never be equitable to all our children. Change in the political system has to happen by the citizens. Until parents demand for a change for Tax Credit, Voucher System and Charter Schools, to say the least, there will be a disparity in the education system and private education will remain open only to those that can afford it. We try our best to make our school affordable. This summer we will learn a lot about these Baltic Region Countries, their national and sophisticated heritage and culture. We will integrate the study of these countries through all our summer learning programs, to include its democratic system, education, philosophy, music and history. The children will enjoy watching slides and photos to include the State Hermitage Museum, the Norwegian Folk Tales and Art, the Winter Sports and many other aspects of these countries lives.

Awesome Special PROGRAMS

(Jr. K to 8th grade)

Language Immersion Program

Children will speak the language of choice for three hours a day with a native language teacher.

- Arabic and French June 21 - July 2

Accelerated Learning Program

For exceptional children in reading and math.
Two week session August 16 - August 27.

Math School

Accelerated 6-week class for Pre-Algebra or Algebra I. Students will receive one full credit for this class. Pre-Algebra is a prerequisite for Algebra I. Session June 21 - July 30.

Creative Writing

For children who enjoy writing and using their imaginations. One week session August 2 - August 6.

Summer School *(ages 4-14 years)*

Summer School starts June 21 and ends August 27. Tuition is \$120 per week from 9:00 a.m. to 12 noon, Monday through Friday. Summer School is for remedial and accelerated curriculum.
